

| Format | General description | Preparation for presenters | Upload before conference |
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| Experience demonstrations [EPD] | <p>Each EPD session opens up with a joint meeting of all presenters and participants in Morressier. Presenters for each EPD can pitch their experience demonstration to the audience in not more than five minutes. Afterwards, participants can choose which EPD they want to join; each EPD will be offered in a separate room (breakout or similar - details under construction); a chair will be present to facilitate the pitching phase; individual experience demonstrations will not be facilitated by a chair but are the responsibility of the individual presenters.</p> | <p>Each presenter/presenting team in the EPD-format should prepare the following: a) a short pitch of their experience demonstration of not more than five minutes (to be presented in a joint meeting at the start of the session); b) their actual experience demonstration as described in the call for papers ("PBL-practice-examples should be presented in a way that allows the audience to experience an innovation, development or variation"), which is not longer than 60 minutes in total (or shorter)</p> | <p>Presenters of individual EPDs will be invited to upload PowerPoint slides of their pitch prior to the session. Presenters will be invited to upload their materials directly by Morressier approx. two weeks prior to the conference. Please note: The technicalities/systems in which individual EPDs will take place are still under consideration; presenters will be informed about the final decisions on this two weeks prior to the conference, if not earlier.</p> |
| Interactive paper sessions [IPS] | <p>Each IPS will contain up to three individual paper presentations; a chair will be present to facilitate the discussion.</p> | <p>Each presenter/presenting team in the IPS-format should prepare an input and a discussion on their paper according to the call for papers ("Present in a way which allows for substantial interaction with the audience"), that is, not more than 15 minutes input and engaging and 15 minutes stimulating questions for the audience that can be answered via the chat.</p> | <p>Presenters will be invited to upload their materials directly by Morressier approx. two weeks prior to the conference.</p> |
| Roundtable discussions [RTD] | <p>Each RTD will contain up to four individual contributions. Presenters for each contribution can present their contribution to the audience in a short input of not more than three minutes. Afterwards, all contributions will be discussed together, facilitated by a chair. The chair will contact presenters approx. two weeks prior to the conference with some guiding questions that will serve as starting point of the discussion.</p> | <p>Each presenter/presenting team in a RTD should prepare the following: a) a presentation of their contribution of not more than three minutes b) answers/statements to the guiding questions that the chair will send out before the RTD</p> | <p>Presenters will be invited to upload their materials directly by Morressier approx. two weeks prior to the conference. Due to system limitations we ask all presenting teams to nominate two main presenters, who will be invited to participate in the RTD via livestream; additional presenters from larger teams are welcome to join the discussion via the chat.</p> |
| Interactive Poster presentations [IPP] | <p>Each IPP will be held for presenters from different time-zones on the platform GatherTown, which will feature a digital ecosystem with designated spaces for each poster. Presenters are expected to be present in their designated space during their scheduled session. There will be also spaces in GatherTown in which participants can meet for informal talk and digital socializing</p> | <p>Presenters in IPP-format should prepare the following: a) a poster of their contribution in PowerPoint/PDF-format; b) (optional) a video comment on their poster (to be uploaded ca. two weeks prior to the conference)</p> | <p>Presenters will be invited to upload their materials directly by Morressier approx. two weeks prior to the conference. There is no need to upload anything directly to GatherTown - this will be done by the conference team.</p> |
